Pursuant to Regulation 17 of the Public Service Commission (Performance Management) Regulations, 2021, the Public Service Commission invites qualified persons to apply for the position of **Member of the Independent Negotiation and Evaluation Committee** for performance contracting. The members of the Committee shall serve on part-time basis for a period not exceeding three years and may be reappointed for one further period not exceeding three years based on satisfactory performance.

#### REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT

A person shall be qualified to be appointed as a member of the Committee if that person:

- a. possesses a minimum of a bachelor's degree from a university recognised in Kenya;
- b. has at least 15 years' professional experience in a relevant field;
- c. has served in a top management position relevant field for at least 5 years;
- d. has knowledge of national development goals;

- e. has experience in performance management; and
- f. satisfies the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

#### The Committee shall be responsible for—

- a) negotiating performance contracts with public bodies;
- b) ensuring that the performance targets of public bodies and indicators are aligned to the strategic plan;
- c) ensuring that performance targets of public bodies are aligned to the performance indicators provided in the strategic plan;
- d) ensuring that the public bodies' indicators are aligned to results that are citizen-focussed;
- e) undertaking mid-year performance reviews of public bodies; and
- f) evaluating the performance of public bodies.
- g) monitoring news coverage and tracking public perceptions of Government policies and initiatives;
- h) collaborating with other Government agencies and departments to coordinate messaging and ensure consistent communication; and
- i) advising Government officials and decision-makers on public relations and media strategies.
